Hot Weather & Water

Calves always benefit from having free choice water. As temperatures begin to rise above 70°F, calves start to use stored body water as they cool themselves off. Often, calves will consume at least twice as much water during hot summer days as compared to cooler spring days.

We strongly recommend providing plenty of fresh water, even if pails must be filled twice daily. Calves close to weaning age and recently weaned calves may drink even more as they transition to a dry diet. A 5-gallon pail can be tied or clipped to a pen or hutch as needed and refilled daily for larger calves who are consuming more water. As always, the pail should be thoroughly cleaned before using it with another calf or group of calves.

The following is a suggested cleaning protocol for washing pails:

1. Pre-wash rinse with lukewarm water
2. Brush vigorously in hot soapy water containing bleach
3. Rinse in an acid solution.
4. Set out to dry.
