DIPPING NAVELS

- 1. Use fresh clean navel dip
 - Always dump soiled dip; use fresh dip before every calf.
 - Navel dip is brown and has an alcohol smell.
- 2. Wash off "MUD" with dip
 - "MUD" is manure, urine and dirt.
 - Use enough dip to get a clean umbilical cord and navel opening at belly.
- 3. Dip the full length of the cord in clean navel dip. Coat navel opening in belly with dip.
