

EXCEDE

Indications:

Treatment of
Respiratory disease
in lactating cows.

Dosage:

1.5cc/100lbs given behind the ear (in fat pad)
subcutaneously only

Route of Administration: Behind ear at base – in
the fat pad – subcutaneously only

If given anywhere else, meat withhold has not
been established. (Contact your vet immediately)

Withholding: Milk: **0 hours**

Meat: **13 days**

Contraindications: Injection into arteries of an
animal's ear is likely to result in sudden death.
Penicillins and cephalosporins can cause allergic
reactions in sensitized individuals.

Storage Conditions: Room temperature
